Paper entries by request only with a \$10 processing fee for 1-4 goats or \$20 for 5 or more goats & must be submitted by 4/24/25.

Money must be received/postmarked by midnight on entry deadline to avoid late fee charges.

Showmanship Classes: \$5.00 (or \$8.00 late)

Entry Fees: Youth Show--\$6.00 Members--per goat, per class OR \$9.00 Non-Members—per goat, per class

Open Show--\$9.00 Members--per goat, per class OR \$12.00 Non-Members—per goat, per class

LATE Entry Fee: Postmarked/ money received after 11:59pm on April 28, 2025.

Add \$3.00 to every class/goat/show, including showmanship.

Uniforms: All 4H, FFA, or Grange members are to wear their uniforms during the youth show only. If not affiliated, independent showmen should wear blue jeans and collared shirt.

Pen Fees: \$8.00 per pen. *No bedding is provided and all bedding placed will need to be cleaned before leaving the fairgrounds by the exhibitor.* Bring a wheelbarrow, rakes, and shovels. The pens are approximately 6'x6' permanent livestock panel type pens. Pens will be assigned and marked for your convenience. Don't forget to reserve a tack pen, if needed.

Bring tarps/covers and/or plastic netting for baby goats as they can get out of pens.

Prospect Wether Class: The purpose of the class is for exhibitors to show bucklings that are going to be wethers but have chosen not to castrate them at an early age. This class will be the first wether class judged at each show. However, they will not compete for Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether.

Sterling Wether/Master Champion: The Master Champion competition will be offered at the beginning of each full show. There must be two Platinum Wethers or three PGCH does / bucks for each competition. If you enter your animal and then are unable to bring it, please contact the show chair immediately so they can contact other owners in the event the class will not meet the required number. *Please register your SW/MCH on the entry form but no payment is required as GSPGA no longer charges for SW/MCH classes*.

Health Check: Only healthy animals are allowed on fairgrounds. Animals with obvious signs of illness (runny noses, eyes, cough) or parasites (scratching or diarrhea) will be requested to leave. No refund on entry fees.

N.P.G.A. RULES TO GOVERN: N.P.G.A. SANCTIONED. Only animals with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than ninety (90) days will be allowed to show. See class list for more info. *Original Registration Papers Must Be Present At The Show.*

Dogs: <u>NO</u> dogs are allowed in the goat barn or surrounding area at any time (except service dogs)! Please keep all dogs away from the show ring.

Silent Auction: There will be Silent Auctions during each day with all proceeds going to GSPGA. Any donations will be *greatly* appreciated. Please tape your name or business card to your donations so we know who to thank!

Awards: Ribbons are awarded for 1st thru 5th places at the Youth Show only. NPGA Rosette Ribbons are awarded to all Champions. Additional prizes will be awarded as well.

Snack bar: We will have a food vendor with breakfast, lunch, snacks, & drinks for sale. Fast food & restaurants nearby.

Camping on Fairgrounds: Dry Camping \$30/night; Electrical and Water hookups \$50/night

Directions to Kern County Fairgrounds/Gate 40:

You can travel to Bakersfield on the I-5, 99, or 58. Most GPS routes will direct you to eventually get on the 58.

From Hwy 58: Take the exit 112 for Union Ave/CA-204, head south on Union Ave. for about 1 mile. Turn right onto Ming Ave. Turn right at Gate 40 (just before the light at South P).

** Turn right inside the gate. The goat barn is to the Northeast, just south of the Big Red Barn.
